## Notice

### WHEREAS:

1. The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application dated June 30, 2010 (Application) from the New Brunswick System Operator (NBSO) for the approval of changes to the Real Power Loss Factor Methodology in the Open Access Transmission Tariff;
2. The NBSO appeared before the Board at a Pre-Hearing Conference held September 1, 2010 and requested an adjournment of the proceeding sine die;
3. The Board has received a letter from NBSO dated Tuesday, November 23, 2010 requesting the proceeding be resumed;
4. NBSO requested that this matter be considered by way of a written proceeding; and
5. NBSO has filed with the Board **revised evidence** that supersedes the evidence filed on June 30, 2010.

### NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. The Board will hold a Pre-Hearing Conference at the Board's offices, 15 Market Square, Suite 1400, Saint John, New Brunswick, on **December 20, 2010** beginning at **9:30 a.m.** Interested parties may attend and make representations about the procedure to be followed and any other relevant matters.
2. **Parties not currently registered** for this proceeding that may wish to intervene should notify the Board and the NBSO, in writing, by **12:00 noon** on **December 13, 2010** at the addresses below. The notice of intervention should state the following:

- whether you wish to have formal or informal status;
  - your choice of language;
  - the reason for the proposed intervention; and
  - the name of the person and any authorized representative of the person and the mailing address, civic address, e-mail address, telephone number, and any other telecommunications numbers of the person or the person's authorized representative.
3. If a party considers that the public interest would be better served by an oral hearing, it should provide the reasons, in writing, to both the Board and the NBSO with the notice of intervention
4. A copy of the **revised Evidence** filed in respect of this matter will be forwarded to those parties **currently** registered.
