

## **NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD**

**IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by the New Brunswick System Operator for the Approval of Changes to the Real Power Loss Factor Methodology in the Open Access Transmission Tariff

### **ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application dated June 30, 2010 (Application) from the New Brunswick System Operator (NBSO) for the approval of changes to the Real Power Loss Methodology in the Open Access Transmission Tariff;

**WHEREAS** the NBSO appeared before the Board at a Pre-Hearing Conference held September 1, 2010 and requested an adjournment of the proceeding sine die;

**WHEREAS** the Board has received a letter from NBSO dated Tuesday, November 23, 2010 requesting the proceeding be resumed;

**WHEREAS** the NBSO requested that this matter be considered by way of a written proceeding; and

**WHEREAS** the NBSO has filed with the Board **revised evidence** that supersedes the evidence filed on June 30, 2010.


### **NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Board will hold a Pre-Hearing Conference at the Board's offices, 15 Market Square, Suite 1400, Saint John, New Brunswick, on December 20, 2010, beginning at 9:30 a.m. Interested parties may attend and make representations about the procedure to be followed and any other relevant matters.
2. Parties who intend to intervene should notify both the Board and the NBSO, in writing, by 12:00 noon on December 13, 2010. The language of preference should be stated in the notice of intervention.

3. If a party considers that the public interest would be better served by means of an oral hearing, it should provide the reasons, in writing, to the Board and the NBSO with the notice of intervention.
4. Time for service of this Notice is abridged, pursuant to section 62 of the Energy and Utilities Board Act. A Notice in substantially the form attached hereto marked "A" shall be provided by the NBSO, in both the English and French language, to all Market Participants and to all electricity license holders on or before the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010. The said Notice shall also be provided to anyone who may request it.
5. A copy of the Application and the evidence is to be provided by the NBSO to all Market Participants and to all electricity license holders on or before the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010. A copy of the Application and the evidence shall also to be provided to anyone who may request it.
6. The Application and the evidence are to be available on the NBSO's website at <http://www.nbso.ca/Public/en/op/regulatory/proceedings.aspx> on or before the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2010.
