

**NEW BRUNSWICK

**IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by the New Brunswick System Operator (NBSO) for the Approval of Changes to the Open Access Transmission Tariff.

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

1. New Brunswick System Operator ("NBSO") is required pursuant to Section 111 of the *Electricity Act*, Chapter E-4.6, R.S.N.B., 1973, (the "Act") as amended to make Application to the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (the "Board") for approval of changes to the Open Access Transmission Tariff (the "Tariff"); and
2. NBSO has filed an Application and supporting Evidence with the Board on October 18, 2010, for the approval of changes to the Tariff.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

- a) A Pre-Hearing Conference shall be held on Tuesday, November 16, 2010, commencing at 9:30 o'clock in the morning at the Delta Brunswick Hotel, Ballroom "C", Saint John, New Brunswick. Intervenors and the Applicant should attend the Pre-Hearing Conference to make representations to the Board with respect to ;
  - the date of the public hearing to consider the Application;
  - the procedure to be followed prior to the public hearing; and
  - any other matters in respect thereto.
- b) The Application and supporting Evidence, as well as a copy of the Board's Order, shall be placed on file for examination by Interested Parties, during normal business hours in the offices of the Board and in the Applicant's business office.

- Indicating their choice of language for the hearing;
- Providing the reason for the nature of the proposed intervention; and
- Setting out the name of the person and any authorized representative of the person and the mailing address, civic address, e-mail address, telephone number, and any other telecommunications numbers of the person or the person's authorized representative.


